What are eLogs

- eLogs is a valuable software tool that allows Residents and their corresponding institutions to meet mandated ACOOG and AOA log requirements in a safe, HIPAA compliant, legible and efficient manner.
- Resident Log forms that are filled out electronically
 - Any Handheld device, iPad, smartphone, android device
 - eLogs Website <https://scselogs.com>
- Resident Logs filled out using eLogs software are a required part of your residency and should be a part of your daily routine. **DO NOT FALL BEHIND**

Mandatory

- All logs must be completed, synced, signed, and turned into Medical Education no later than 7 days past the end of your service
- e.g. July's logs must be completed and signed by Aug. 7th

Mandatory -- First Year Osteopathic OB Residents

- Medicine Rotations
 - Log ALL patient encounters
 - Log ALL procedures
- OB Rotations
 - Log procedures only
 - Ambulatory clinic log only cases w/procedures
- All first year Osteopathic OB residents are required to log their Reading and Education activity.

Types of Logs – Required

- **Contract Year*****
 - Used to designate your contract year, generally but does not always follow the Academic year
- **Master Schedule*****
 - Your Schedule, your rotations/service
- **Educational Programs:**
 - Used to log all lectures, talks or demonstrations attended or given, such as but not limited to noon lectures, weekly departmental lectures and SCS education days.
- **Reading Program:**
 - Used to log assigned and optional reading done during the rotation such as, but not limited to, journal club activities, text book reading assignments and case research.

Types of Logs – Most Used

- **Case Logs DO:**
 - Used for all Hospital and Clinical Case encounters during all Primary Care Rotations such as IM, FM, PEDS, NICU, ICU and Surgical rotations: pre-op and post-op, Clinic activity.
- **Surgery:**
 - Used for all Non-OBGYN OR and bedside surgical procedures.

Types of Logs – Specialty

- **OBGYN Gynecologic Case Log**
 - Used by OBGYN and OB FEL residents to log all GYN and GYN ONC procedures
- **OBGYN Obstetric Case Log**
 - Used by OBGYN and OB FEL residents to log all Obstetric procedures
- **OBGYN Other Procedures Case Log**
 - Used by OBGYN and OB FEL residents to log all “other cases” including OMM/OMT
